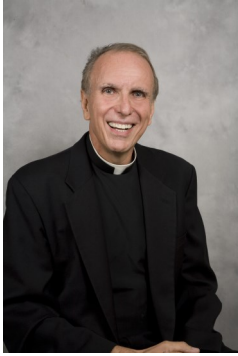

### Twelve Steps for Finding Mercy in your Life

**There are areas in everyone's life that needs healing, that longs for a deeper peace and freedom. It is our addictions that prevent us from receiving these gifts. We are all addicted, not necessarily to alcohol, drugs, overeating, sex or gambling, but we are all addicted to wanting to control, to play God or maybe we are addicted to our desires for success, money or wanting to be liked. Our retreat session will be about the twelve tools that are at the heart of Alcoholics Anonymous and how we can all use these tools to become free, joyful human beings who can bring mercy and compassion to others**

Father Tony will also speak at the 5:00 p.m. Mass on Saturday, September 17, and the 8:00, 10:00 a.m., and 12:00 Noon Masses on September 18.

Mercy! Mercy! Pope Francis tells us in this Jubilee Year, "Do Not Be Afraid of Mercy!" We will open the doors of our hearts to mercy and discover how mercy can change your life.

A member of Voluntas Dei, Father Anthony Ciorra was ordained at priest in 1973. His pastoral experience has included parish life, teaching, administration, retreat work, preaching, and formation ministries. He holds graduate degrees in psychology, history, and pastoral theology, and a certificate in Spiritual Direction, as well as a Ph.D. in Theology from Fordham University.

He is the Author of several books: **Everyday Mysticism**, a book about spirituality in the marketplace; **Beauty: A Way to God**. He co-authored **Moral Formation in the Parish**, a work about living Christian and moral values in the world. He edited the book, **Vatican II: A Universal Call to Holiness**, on the occasion of the fiftieth anniversary of the Council. He has produced audio and video presentations on Thomas Merton, the History of Christian Spirituality, the Spirituality of Vatican II, Gratitude, the Twelve Steps of Alcoholics Anonymous for Everyone, the Seven Great Schools of Christian Spirituality and a Retreat with Pope Francis.

In recognition of his ministry in the Church, he was awarded with the pontifical 'Pro Ecclesia et Pontifice' by Pope John Paul II in 1999 and with the Caritas Centennial Award in 2000 for his work in lay ministry and the Spirit of Renew award for his work in interreligious dialogue and ecumenism.

He currently serves as Professor of Theology and Associate Vice-President for Mission and Catholic Identity at Sacred Heart University in Fairfield, Connecticut. Previously he was Dean of the Graduate School of Religion and Religious Education at Fordham University, Director of the Center for Theological and Spiritual Development at the College of Saint Elizabeth, Director for the Center for Spiritual Development in the Archdiocese of New York. He gives workshops and retreats throughout the United States, the Middle East and Europe.
