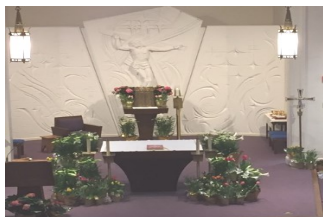
FATHER ENGLISH CENTER
